

Asthma Control Test

- Alert will trigger if Asthma Control Test has not occurred in the last 1 month. Alert only applies to patients 6-64 years old. Patient must have Asthma. Patient must not have Cystic Fibrosis or Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD).
- This alert is configurable.

Asthma Control Therapy

- Alert will trigger if patient age 5-64 has been identified as having persistent asthma but has not been prescribed asthma control medication. Will not trigger if patient has an active diagnosis of Emphysema, COPD, Obstructive Chronic Bronchitis, Cystic Fibrosis, or Acute Respiratory Failure.
- This alert is not configurable.

Asthma Severity

- Alert will trigger if Asthma Severity has not occurred in the last 1 year. Patient must have Asthma.
- This alert is configurable.

Asthma Action Plan

- Alert will trigger if Asthma Action Plan has not occurred in the last 1 year. Alert only applies to patients 5-64 years old. Patient must have Persistent Asthma, and must not have Obstructive Chronic Bronchitis or Emphysema or Cystic Fibrosis or COPD or Acute Respiratory Failure.
- This alert is configurable.

Common Side Effects:

- Your throat might feel scratchy.
- · You could get a headache.
- Your voice might sound
- You might get a white spot in your mouth. Call us if this happens.

Storage and Care:

- Keep the cap on when not
- Store in a dry place, not too hot or cold.
- · Clean inside and outside of mouthpiece with a dry cloth.
- Clean it every week.
- Throw away 3 months after you open it. Or when the counter says "0".
- Clean nozzle with q-tip if no spray is coming out of inhaler.

Priming Needed? Yes

When to prime

- First time using it.
- If you drop the inhaler.
- If you haven't used it in a week.

How to prime:


- 1.Shake well before each
- 2.Spray 2 times into the air, away from your face.
- 3.Use as normal.

School Based Provider Education

- Patient is 18 y.o. female with history of depression with anxiety, and asthma. Patient stated she had another PCP for her asthma, but was willing to switch if she "couldn't get in" to other provider.
- ACT on 2/23/23 was 18. Was complaining of feeling more emotional, but improvement in racing thoughts.
- Does not currently use tobacco but does have exposure to secondhand smoke

New Undiagnosed asthma/COPD Walkthrough

Only possible if patient able to perform peak flow

Calculate Estimated Peak Flow

https://www.mdcalc.com/calc/790/estimated-expected-peak-expiratory-flow-peak-flow#pearls-pitfalls

Have patient perform 3 peak flows

Take the Best of 3 scores and document in Asthma/COPD form in pre-bronchodilator box

Pre-Bronchodilator Peak Flow Expected Peak Flow x 100=% of expected

Updated 2023

% of Expected >88%

No albuterol treatment needed due to improvement not being meaningful. Rules out COPD

Assess asthma symptoms and diagnose if appropriate. Assess control using ACT

Update patient Diagnosis according to staging table and treat accordingly

Asthma Diagnosis Codes

- J45.20 Mild Intermittent Asthma
- J45.30 Mild Persistent Asthma
- J45.40 Moderate Persistent Asthma
- J45.50 Severe Persistent Asthma

COPD Diagnosis Codes

- J44.9 Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease, uncomplicated
- J44.0 Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease with acute lower respiratory infection
- J44.1 Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease with acute exacerbation

Special Cases

If >80% of expected but less than <12% improvement with albuterol treatment, consider pulmonary follow up for spirometry

Alert will trigger if Asthma Control Test has not occurred in the last 1 years, or is due in the next 1 months, or if the Asthma Control Test value is <= 19. Alert only applies to patients > = 5 yrs old and <= 100 yrs old. Patient must have Asthma. Patient must not have Cystic Fibr osis or Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD).





The further from an Action Plan start date, the more likely patients were to end up at hospitals.


• 0-90 days: 14 visits


