In anticipation of CY2023 UDS+ electronic data submission of patient-level detail (which is voluntary, but actively encouraged by HRSA for CY2023), Azara Healthcare has begun to collect the information necessary to facilitate this transmission. As part of the process, we need to ensure we know who from your organization will be authorized to 'opt in' your health center for the HRSA data submission. While your administrators will continue to have full control over who can access and view reports and measure data, only one person per organization will be able to authorize and 'opt in' the transmission of your data to HRSA from Azara DRVS. Before submission, the authorized user will be prompted to confirm their Health Center information (including Grantee # and UEI) and acknowledge they have reviewed the information to be sent and are authorized to initiate the submission.

By completing the information below and signing this form, you agree that the named staff member is authorized to submit your health center's UDS+ information to HRSA from Azara DRVS. If the named staff member does not have an Azara DRVS login, one will be created for them.

#### Azara UDS+ Updates





4/2 First round of voluntary submissions completed

- Azara was the first vendor to successfully send production data to HRSA
- Azara submitted for 55 centers



2<sup>nd</sup> Cohort of voluntary submissions to take place through end of June

 Allows centers to participate who do not have full patient population within a single system

(i.e., Dental data is not in DRVS)

HRSA will have reviews of UDS+ results for the centers who submitted

"Expected" that UDS+ calculated results closely match EHB-reported results


